3-Advanced Search (with logical operators)

A logical operator defines logical relationships between terms in a search, to create a very broad or very narrow search. The operators are:

AND	OR	NOT
Results contain all search terms.	Results contain at least one search term.	Results do not contain the specified terms.
Search <i>Africa and Asia</i> finds items that contain both Africa and Asia .	Search <i>Africa or Asia</i> finds items that contain either Africa or items that contain <i>Asia</i> .	Search <i>Africa not Asia</i> finds items that contain <i>Africa but do not contain Asia</i> .

When you search Globethics.net Library, the syntax requires logical operators be capitalized (AND, OR, NOT), you would mainly use **Advanced Search**, where you can enter search terms in each field, and select **AND, OR, and NOT** from the logical operators drop-down lists.

4-Exact Phrase Search puts words in quotation marks, so the exact sequence of terms within the quotation marks (in the same order) is being matched:
